



Offline SEOmoz database instructions

To extract and import the SEOmoz crawl data, follow the steps below. You need to have an SEOmoz account to do this. If you don't have one then a free [30 day trial is available here](#). You will also need Microsoft Access 2002 or above.

SEOmoz Data Export

- Log in to your [SEOmoz account here](#)
- Choose **Campaigns** from the top bar.
- Choose **View this Campaign** on the site you want to look at.
- Scroll down to **Crawl Diagnostics** and click on the **See All Crawl Alerts** button.
- In the top right corner where it says **Export page to**, change this to **CSV** and click on the **Export** button.
- Once this file has downloaded, you HAVE to name it **data.csv** and paste it into your **c:** directory. So your file will be here when completed, **C:\data.csv**. The reason for this is that Microsoft Access has a few issues with relative file imports. The import has to be from an absolute position.

Import your data into the offline database

- Open the database using Microsoft Access 2002 or above from your ZIP download. **Premium/offline-moz-crawl-db/offline-seomoz-db.mdb**.
- You will need to **enable** the **VBA Macro** if prompted by Microsoft Access.
- When the database has opened, you will be presented with an **Import Raw Data** button.
- Please ensure that your data file is in **C:\data.csv** and then click on the **Import Raw Data** button.
- A message box will be displayed; any data currently in the database will be deleted to make room for the new data. If you are **happy** with this, click on the **YES** button.
- After about 10 seconds you will be presented with a complete report for your website.
- Should this be a little on the large side, then you can view the individual components from the new form that has appeared on the screen.
- That's it. Read the reports and fix all the errors.
